BHS Symphony is FIRST in the State!!!

The BHS Symphony was recently named the TMEA High School String Honor Orchestra for 2006-2007. Competing against 30 other groups from across the state, BHS was ranked $1^{\rm st}$ by the judges in the preliminary round and in the final round. As a result of this honor, the BHS symphony will be performing at the Texas Music Education Association Convention, held in San Antonio, on February 15, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. The TMEA Convention is the largest music convention in the country.

This is the highest honor that a music group can achieve in Texas. BHS was also the Honor Orchestra in 1987, exactly 20 years ago!

We are extremely proud of this accomplishment!!!


