It seemed as if it had been forever since the All-State Orchestra auditions last fall when sophomores Thomas Baek and Hanna Choi left for the TMEA convention held in San Antonio from February 11-14. They both performed in the All-State String Orchestra (Thomas on violin, Hanna on piano) under the baton of Kirt Mosier – who had also written one of their pieces. It's very rare to get to play music by a living composer, much less be conducted by him! (Students in Concert, Philharmonic, and Chamber orchestras may recognize Mr. Mosier's name – he is the composer of "Baltic Dance.") We are honored that Hanna and Thomas represented the BHS Orchestra at the clinic and concert.

UIL season has also come and gone, and all of the BHS orchestras gave wonderful performances after much hard work......

#### **2009 UIL RESULTS**

- \*The Symphony Orchestra received the UIL Sweepstakes (Superior ratings in both Concert and Sight-Reading) award in BOTH string and full orchestra categories the only orchestra in the region to perform this feat.
- \*The Philharmonic Orchestra (the only Non-Varsity Full Orchestra in the region to attend UIL) also received the Sweepstakes award in Full Orchestra.
- \*The Concert Orchestra (the only "Sub- Non-Varsity" group in the region to attend UIL) received a Superior rating in Concert and an Excellent rating in Sight-Reading.

By the time you read this newsletter, the BHS Orchestras will also have performed in Corpus Christi as part of their annual spring trip. Details will be announced at the concerts. The Symphony also will have played along with the Lake Highlands HS Orchestra at the annual Council of PTAs concert.
